## Nomination Process

<p><b>Upon Acceptance of Nomination</b></p>	<p>After applicants receive notice that the nomination has been accepted by UNT, they must complete the UNT Incoming Exchange Student Application at <a href="https://mystudyabroad.unt.edu/?go=INCX">mystudyabroad.unt.edu/?go=INCX</a></p>

## Class Registration

<b>Selecting Courses</b>	<p>Students may register for courses after they receive their EUID and password and have paid the non-refundable <b>\$45 orientation fee</b>.</p> <p>Undergraduates must register for at least 12 credit hours. Undergraduate courses are listed as 1000-4000.</p> <p>Graduate students must register for at least 9 credit hours. <b>Courses Not Available to Exchange Students</b>	<p>Courses offered online, at UNT's Health Science Center, at UNT's Frisco campus, at UNT's Dallas campus, or through UNT's Intensive English Language Institute are not available to exchange students</p> <p>Art, Journalism, Music and Media Arts courses are restricted and may be available with the approval of the department.</p>

## Housing

<b>On-Campus Housing</b>	<p>On-campus housing is not guaranteed and students should apply for housing as soon as they receive their EUID from UNT. Incoming students pay a deposit as part of the housing application process.
