Amount is found on Certification of Financial Resources Form. ## Class Registration

<b>Selecting Courses</b>	Students may register for courses after they receive their UNT I.D. and password and submit a completed course enrollment request form.
	Undergraduates must register for at least 12 credit hours. Undergraduate courses are listed as 1000-4000. Graduate students must register for at least 9 credit hours. Graduate courses are listed as 5000-6000. <b>Courses Not Available to Exchange Students</b>	Courses at UNT's Health Science Center, at UNT's Frisco campus, at UNT's Dallas campus, or through UNT's Intensive English Language Institute are not available to exchange students. Art, Journalism, Music and Media Arts courses are restricted, but may be available with departmental approval. Restrictions apply to enrollment in online courses for J-1 exchange students.

## Housing

On-Campus Housing	On-campus housing is <b>not</b> guaranteed but should be available to students who complete the housing application when housing applications open. Students will be required to pay a deposit to hold their room as part of the housing application process. Students must adhere to all university housing deadlines. Summer housing is not available.
